

Audio/Video Equipment Requirements.

- One wireless lavalier microphone
- Very large projection screen
- Multi media projector (1600 lumens minimum) for Greg's multi-media presentation
- Stage or riser for audiences of 100 or more with spot lighting to reduce bleeding on to the projection screen
- Greg controls the audio/video presentation from a MacBook Air laptop computer which is placed on a special stand (provided by Greg). This stand needs access to AC power, a VGA extension cable connected to the projector, and a sound cable (standard small headphones jack) connected to the sound system.
- If a lectern/podium is on stage, please ensure it is stage left or right, as Greg uses most of the stage.
- Greg requires a meeting with an AV technician for a rehearsal of audio/video equipment setup one day prior to the speaking engagement.

NOTE:

- Greg's presentation is multi-media, including images, video and sound, all contained within a custom Mac application
- This application runs on the MacBook Air laptop which needs to be plugged into the projector, power and sound system.
- The media is controlled by Greg using a remote and the laptop on his stand must be within view of Greg at all times during the presentation. The laptop is small and mounted low on the stand to maintain a clear, unobstructed view of Greg from the audience.
- Greg will provide the adapter required to plug a standard VGA cable into the MacBook Air.
- Greg's multi-media presentation has a resolution of 1024 X 768 – please ensure the projector is compatible
